

Man gets 3-month jail for drunken driving

Setting a deterrent for drunk drivers, the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate Anubhav Sharma sentenced a habitual drunk driver to three months

imprisonment and imposed a fine of Rs 3,000 on him.

The convict, Rajeshwar, a resident of Phase IX, Mohali, was issued a challan for drunken driving by the UT traffic police on December 6 when alcohol content in his blood was found to be

154.4mg/100 ml, much above the permissible limit of 30mg/100 ml. He was earlier also issued a similar challan on August 27 this year.

The convict was challaned at the Sector 49/50 intersection when he was found to be driving vehicle number

PB65P-1390 under influence of alcohol.

“Earlier also, you committed the said offence on August 27, 2015, thus you have committed offence under section 185 of the Motor Vehicle Act with
